MOBILITY OF PRIVATE PERSONS

General rules of behaviour:

The physical distancing of at least one meter remains in force: when this distance cannot be respected, and in public places (from public transport to shops), a mask must be worn.

The distance should be doubled in case of physical activity.

Gatherings are forbidden in public places, or places open to the public. Events and shows of any nature, with the presence of public, including those of a cultural, recreational, sporting and fair nature, as well as any convention or congress activity, in a public place or place open to the public, take place, where deemed possible, on the basis of the trend of epidemiological data, with the methods established with the measures adopted pursuant to article 2 of decree-law no. 19 of 2020.

When traveling by car, however, the use of masks is mandatory if the distance of one meter is not ensured, except between co-habitants.

In Friuli Venezia Giulia, as of June 4th, the obligation to wear the mask is valid only in indoor places accessible to the public and, outside only when the safety distance of one meter can not be guaranteed (except between co-habitants).

Entry in Italy

As of June 3rd, 2020, Italy reopens its borders to the countries of the Schengen area (26 countries that cover almost the entire European Union, plus others including the United Kingdom, Switzerland and Iceland). It will therefore be possible for foreign visitors to enter our territory without having to undergo the 14 days of quarantine previously provided.

Entry in Friuli Venezia Giulia

As of June 3rd, it is possible to freely move on the entire Italian territory, without the self-certification form. The entry in Friuli Venezia Giulia is allowed, accordingly.

Exit from Italy

– As of June 3rd, exit from Italian territory is allowed, without certification.

As some EU and NON EU States, as well as some neighbouring States, allow Italian citizens to enter their Countries only for specific and urgent reasons, Italian travellers are advised to check the situation and rules applying in their destination Country (<http://www.viaggiasesicuri.it/country/>).

– Departures from Italy by plane: flight connections are slowly restoring in most of the Italian airports. Carriers and shipowners shall obtain and verify the documentation required from travellers before boarding, taking care to take temperature measurements of individual passengers and forbidding boarding in case of fever higher than 37.5°, as well as because of incomplete documentation.

Carriers and shipowners are also required to adopt any necessary measures to ensure at all times an interpersonal distance of at least one meter between passengers during the journey, and to promote the use of individual means of protection by the crew and passengers, providing clear directions concerning any situations in which such protections may be temporarily removed. Air carriers shall ensure that all passengers without protection are provided with personal protective equipment upon boarding.

The above provisions shall not apply to:

- transport crew
- travelling personnel belonging to companies with registered offices in Italy
- health personnel entering Italy to practice activities connected to their professional health qualifications, including temporary practice
- cross-border workers entering and leaving the national territory for proven reasons of work and the consequent return to their residence, dwelling or homestay.

As of June 3rd, the mandatory temperature measurement is mandatory for all passengers on long-distance trains, as well. In case of temperature higher than 37.5°, access will not be allowed.

Passthrough Italy

– - Transit through Italy, from one foreign country to another, is allowed. Travellers are advised to check the situation and rules applying in their destination Country

Public transport in Friuli Venezia Giulia

- City bus transport restored the normal schedule. Trains and intercity bus connections are slowly normalising. Passengers must wear masks or nose / mouth protectors if it is not possible to guarantee the distance of at least 1 m.

MOBILITY OF GOODS

Goods transport is not subject to any restrictions

Transport HUB (airports, ports, inland terminals) : open

Transport by road: allowed. The ban on the circulation of goods vehicles heavier than 7.5 tonnes on Italian motorways, during holidays has been restored.

For the export of goods, it is possible to get information on truck border crossing time in Europe at the website:

Transport by rail: allowed

Transport by sea: allowed

BORDERS ACTIVITIES

The circulations of goods for the import is allowed.

As regards to the land borders, no self declaration is required to staff travelers (Drivers) in charge of the road transport of goods or passengers.

CUSTOMS ACTIVITIES

Along with the usual custom clearance process for the goods, simplified customs procedure are applied for the import of Personal Protective Equipment – protective masks. The guidelines are published on the Italian

ECONOMIC ACTIVITIES

As of June 4th, the following social, cultural and economic activities are allowed in Friuli Venezia Giulia, upon respect of the general rules of behaviour related to the emergency and according to the Provision of the President of Friuli Venezia Giulia Region n. 16:

- a) Restaurants
- b) tourist activities (resorts and beaches)
- c) accommodation facilities
- d) hairdressers, beauty salons and tattoo shops
- e) retail sale
- f) retail trade in public areas (markets and markets for hobbyists)
- g) offices open to the public
- h) pools
- i) gyms
- j) services for green maintenance
- k) museums, archives and libraries
- l) tourist facilities - outdoor accommodation
- m) alpine huts
- n) open air physical activities
- o) vehicle and other equipment rental
- p) pharmaceutical sales representatives
- q) play areas for children
- r) cultural and recreational circles
- s) professional training
- t) cinemas and theatres
- u) amusement parks
- v) festivals and fairs
- w) services for kids and teenagers
- x) spa facilities and wellness centers
- y) mountain professions (alpine guides and ski instructors) and tourist guides
